Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS) Compliance

Dear Valued Customers,

In 2003, the European Union enacted environmental legislation restricting the use of certain substances in electrical and electronic products starting in July 2006. Many other countries are now adopting this directive or implementing similar initiatives. IDENTCO has prepared for these initiatives and deadlines since early 2004, and have become 100% RoHS Compliant. I have confirmed with our raw material suppliers that IDENTCO labels and thermal transfer ribbons are well below the threshold limits for the following;

Lead	<1000PPM
Mercury	<1000PPM
Cadmium	<100PPM
Hexavalent Chromium	<1000PPM
Polybrominated Biphenyls	<1000PPM
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers	<1000PPM

These materials are not intentionally used during the manufacturing process, so there should be no accidental contamination during the production of our products. Therefore we consider these products complaint to Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS). The information contained herein is based on data considered to be accurate and is offered at no charge. IDENTCO International did not perform these tests on the materials independently, but we rely & trust our various suppliers' data to be accurate and correct.
